### CALL FOR PROPOSALS

The Telluride Association seeks instructors to teach engaging, discussion-based summer programs for summer 2011. The Telluride Association Sophomore Seminar (TASS) brings together 18 talented high school sophomores to focus on an intensive six-week long, discussion-based seminar that focuses on understanding race and social difference as central concepts for the understanding of society. Since its inception in 1993, TASS has drawn students without the lure of grades or college credit. The Telluride Association, in conjunction with its university partners, offers TASS tuition-free to all students. The University of Michigan Ann Arbor will host one, six-week long TASS from: **26 June 2011 to 6 August 2011.**

### ELIGIBILITY, DUTIES, AND COMPENSATION

This site is open to all qualified applicants. Applicants should hold an advanced degree and a track record of excellent teaching. The Telluride Association Sophomore Seminar Committee will select two professors to co-teach the seminar offered at the University of Michigan. Each instructor receives a competitive stipend for program preparation, six weeks of teaching, and written student evaluations. Instructors are expected to work collaboratively with TASS tutors, college-aged program counselors who mentor TASS students in all aspects of the seminar and extracurricular life, but especially in writing composition and expression.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Faculty applicants should write a coherent proposal justifying its relevance in light of TASS's call to raise awareness on the nature of race and difference as central concepts to understanding society. Proposals should evaluate some aspect of society, culture, and governance, broadly conceived. Please submit a *joint* teaching statement, CVs for both co-instructors, draft syllabus with reading list, and five recent narrative student evaluations for *each* instructor, all in PDF to: **[2011programs@tellurideassociation.org](mailto:2011programs@tellurideassociation.org)**.
